

## **OPEN CALL FOR EXHIBITIONS AT KULA GALLERY FOR 2025. ANNUAL PROGRAM**

Kula gallery is announcing an open call for exhibitions in 2025, which will be open from November 13 till December 25, 2024.

Located in the former brewery complex in the center of Belgrade, within the renovated clock tower, Gallery Kula is a space for developing artistic projects focused on illustration, graphic design, drawing, photography, and authorial works. Since 2021, the gallery has been showcasing the best examples of illustration from Serbia and the region. Our exhibition program equally supports both established and emerging artists.

We encourage illustrators, graphic designers, and printmakers to apply for this call. However, there will always be space at Kula for other art forms, including painting, sculpture, performance, dance, new media art, photography, and conceptual art. We kindly ask that all exhibition and project proposals be specifically tailored for the gallery's first floor.

The selection will be made by the Kula team, consisting of: Marko Radojković, Bojana Ljubišić, Bojana Jovanović, Andreja Krstić, Ana Stanojević, and Ivana Rašović.

### **– THE CALL IS OPEN FOR**

- Solo exhibitions
- Group exhibitions
- Author's / Curator selected exhibitions
- Short, one-day or evening presentations / Screenings / Book Promotions / Discussions / Panels or other events in the field of contemporary art
- Sound and music events

## **II – PARTICIPATION CRITERIA**

- Kula gallery dedicates the majority of its program to promoting illustrators, designers, and printmakers, as well as other artists from Serbia and the region. International collaborations are welcome!
- The call has no restrictions regarding the nationality of the applicants.

## **III – REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS**

- **PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** up to 300 words describing the project.
- **CV with contact information:** The biography and portfolio should be no larger than 5 MB, in PDF format.
- **VISUAL AND OTHER DOCUMENTATION**
  - Up to 10 reproductions/illustrations of the project you are applying with (total size up to 10 MB, in JPG or PNG format).
  - In case that the project is not completed, is in progress, or based on time/duration, performance or other, please provide an additional description of the appearance and the idea of the project (up to 200 words), with a preferred visualisation of the project in the form of sketches, 3D models or spatial visualisation
  - Sound and video: Upload your files to platforms such as Vimeo or YouTube and send the links. If the content is password-protected, make sure to include the password. The links must remain active until December 25.
- **TECHNICAL LIST:** A list of technical equipment that the gallery will provide is attached to the call.

## **IV – WHAT GALLERY KULA PROVIDES**

- Exhibition space
- PR activity (announcement of the exhibition via our mailing list and social media: Facebook event, Instagram)
- Available technical equipment (LED spotlights with suspension rails, dimmable spotlights, two LED panels, five panels, Bluetooth speaker, microphone and stands, amplifiers, mixer rental if necessary, headphones, short throw projector, players and USB adapters, laptop, projection screen, 6 pedestals of various sizes, all required display equipment)
- Drinks at the exhibition opening
- Printed materials (brochures)
- Installation of works

## **V – WHAT THE EXHIBITOR PROVIDES**

- Transport of works
- Any additional equipment and technical support not provided by Gallery Kula
- Travel expenses and accommodation
- Dismantling, packaging, and removal of works at the end of the exhibition, returning the space to its original condition

## **VI – HOW TO APPLY**

- Application materials should be submitted via a file-sharing platform such as WeTransfer. After uploading, send the link to [kula@kisobran.org](mailto:kula@kisobran.org).
- One artist can submit multiple applications.
- Applicants must commit to realizing the accepted project within the agreed timeline.

## **VII – APPLICATION DEADLINE**

- The deadline for submitting applications is December 25, 2024 (by midnight).
- Incomplete applications or applications received after the deadline will not be considered.
- The decision on accepted projects will be made by January 25, 2025, and all participants will be notified via email.
